

HISTORY

- Created in 1997, the ATHENS Network is made up of 14 leading European technological universities and nine ParisTech Graduate Schools of Engineering.
- The principal goal of the Network is to facilitate the exchange of students, teachers and researchers from major European technological universities and to participate together under European technological development and training programmes.
- The Network was established with the support of the European Communities SOCRATES Programme, receiving an annual subsidy from 1997-2001. Today the Programme is mainly funded by contributions from the member institutions.

INTENSIVE COURSE PROGRAMME

- Twice a year, the ATHENS Network organizes a programme of 7-day intensive courses at member institutions.
- The programme, known as the ATHENS week includes a wide range of courses in engineering and social sciences as well as a number of "European Dimension" activities in each country.
- The objective of the programme is to give students a brief immersion in another European education system. It permits participants from different institutions to take short courses of a high scientific level and to mix with students of different nationalities and backgrounds.
